

# 1. Box style

Our designs follow and expand on the standard industry styles. Take a look at our most popular styles below, but there are many more to choose from if you can't see the style you want.



#### 2. Box size

Determine the size of your box by measuring the length, width and depth of your product. Box dimensions are measured internally to ensure they fit your product correctly.



#### 3. Material

The performance of your bespoke box is dependent on the liner and fluting used and both can be varied in terms of grammage and recycled content. Consider new, lighter weight flutes which use less material without forfeiting strength and are great to print on.



If you are unsure of the material grade required the information in the table below gives a rough guide. Alternatively let us know about your product and we will help you.



# **Printing Processes**

Your choice of print method depends on branding, quantity and budget. Our knowledgeable customer service team will be happy to advise.

### **Digital Printing**

This is a newer type of printing which continues to advance. An image is sent directly to the printer using a digital file. The ink is applied directly onto the surface, removing the need for a printing plate. Often used for point of sale (POS), retail ready packaging (RRP), product launches and promotions, e-commerce packaging and most other applications where small quantities, large format or one-time designs are required.

- Fast turnaround
- Good print reproduction
- Reduced production cost as printing plates are not required
- · Small quantities can be produced
- Variable data allows personalization



This printing process uses a flexible rubber or polymer relief plate, also known as a stereo and the ink is applied over a steel roller. It is ideal for corrugated printing and continuous designs (wallpaper effect) are easily achieved.

- Wide variety of inks and varnishes
- Up to 8 colour print

# **Lithographic Printing (Offset)**

A high quality and consistent printing method whereby an image, from a metal plate is transferred onto a rubber blanket and the image transferred onto the material by applying pressure.

Often used for point of sale (POS), retail ready (RRP), cartons, e-commerce packaging and many other applications which require high-end, magazine quality reproduction of images.

- Very high quality image reproduction
- High level of detail and precision
